Lighting of the Advent Wreath

Celebrant: Today is the first Sunday of Advent. The Sunday in which we recall the Hope we have in Christ. The prophets of Israel all spoke of the coming of Christ, of how a savior would be born, a king in the line of David. They spoke of how he would rule the world wisely and bless all nations.
